- Promote the journal within academic and activist networks.

Nominees should demonstrate:

- Recognized expertise in feminist theory, gender studies, or related fields in the humanities and social sciences.

- Commitment to intersectionality, inclusivity, and global perspectives.
- Ability to work collaboratively within an international editorial team.
- Excellent communication skills in English.

Institutional support for the nominee's editorial responsibilities is highly desirable. The expected term of service is three years, with the possibility of renewal.

3. A statement of relevant editorial and leadership experience.
